<p>Student Health and Counseling (SHAC) (505) 277-3136 (24-hour phone line)</p> <p>Counseling, crisis intervention, and comprehensive medical services for eligible UNM students. SHAC can help expedite referrals to SANE for evidence collection.</p>	<p>UNM Counseling and Referral Services (CARS) (505) 272-6868</p> <p>Free counseling services for eligible UNM staff, faculty, and their spouses/domestic partners, and retirees.</p>
<p>Rape Crisis Center of Central New Mexico (505) 266-7711 (24-hour phone line)</p> <p>Operates a 24-hour hotline, as well as victim advocates and free counseling.</p>	<p>Manzanita Counseling Center (505) 277-7311</p> <p>A counselor training facility affiliated with the Counselor Education Program in the UNM College of Education. <p>Office of Equal Opportunity (505) 277-5251</p> <p>OEO investigates alleged violations of UNM policies prohibiting sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct. OEO houses UNM's Title IX Coordinator.</p>	<p>Sexual Misconduct and Assault Response Team (SMART)</p> <p>SMART is a victim centered, victim controlled, coordinated response team composed of community and UNM organizations designed to quickly respond to cases of sexual misconduct.</p>
LAW ENFORCEMENT	
<p>UNM Police Department (UNMPD) (505) 277-2241</p>	<p>For On-Campus Emergences, Call 911. Specially trained SMART officers will respond to and investigate alleged sex crimes on the UNM campus and will forward cases to the District Attorney's Office as appropriate. If the alleged sex crime occurred off campus, UNMPD can assist an individual who has experienced sexual misconduct in contacting the appropriate law enforcement agency to file a report.</p>
